	paying members last month. Total paying members 348, exceeds full	PG/AA
	year budget by 37. 62 half year members. Since the start of the	
	online new members process we have had 95 enquiries [end of July].	
	59 have completed a trial, 27 have become members. However we	
	are now reaching coaching capacity. Most groups are full or nearing capacity. PG reported that he feels that it is still not the right time to	
	hand over the new members email enquiries. The correspondence	
	takes up a lot of time. We may look at an automated response.	
	 Volunteers – PB and PG have looked at how other clubs recruit 	
	volunteer [best called 'helper outers' or use a phrase like 'lend a	PG
	hand make difference]. Good to see that our appeal for an awards organiser was successful. We are planning to send out another letter	
	appealing for volunteers, but not sure on the timing, probably the end	
	of September. PG composing the letter. We will use a shorter	
	messages, requesting help, on social media. The Awards Evening	
	may be an opportunity to recruit helpers.	
	 Safety, Welfare & Grievances- No reports. Club Standards & Governance - EA Club Standards. We fulfil six 	
	of the seven standards. We fail on coaches qualifications. AA went	
	through the six coaches concerned. AA and PG to speak to coaches	
	who need to complete First Aid or Safeguarding courses. Some	
	discussion on how unqualified coaches have EA insurance.	
	Committee not concerned with senior athletes. Possibility of using Association of Road Running Clubs insurance for some coaches.	
	Performance/Event Management – Indoor bookings. The rates	
	have increased by 10%. Look at changing club times on Tuesday	
	and Thursday to 1800-2000, by doing so we would half our indoor	
	booking costs for Beagles Plus and Mini Beagles. More consultation	
	required with coaches who use the indoors. Weights Areas. The club now has the use of GLL weights room during club hours. AA not	
	sure if it is suitable and equipment not suitable for athletes' needs.	
	Storage . Discussion on where club equipment, beast, bars, plates	
	and yellow boxes will now be stored. PG reported in the long term	
	GLL intend to supply the club with storage space. In addition we are	
	not sure what will happen to the space under the 'lean to'. Track and Field Competitions 2025 . MB pointed out that junior leagues will	
	look at restructuring in 2026 when theage groups change. We will	
	need to decide which leagues to enter in October. The committee will	
	make the decision in October after consulting team managers and	
	coaches. We will also look at the possibility of alternative	
	competitions with local clubs. • Communication – Thanks to Pete Webster for another excellent
